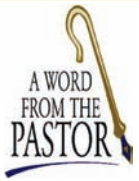

With the turkey and stuffing leftovers gone and the Eagles sliding into a losing season, we find ourselves at the beginning of December and now the *Second* Sunday of Advent with just three weeks to Christmas Day. I am grateful to Matt Kirsch and his many young volunteers who switched out the missalettes last weekend for the start of our new liturgical year. Thank you to all who have already taken a tag or tags from our Giving Trees in the narthex. The kindness and generosity of our people is legendary.

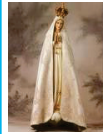
Saint John the Baptist makes his appearance in our Gospel this weekend announcing, *"Repent, for the kingdom of heaven is at hand!"* This charismatic and alluring figure invites us to *"Prepare the way of the Lord, make straight His paths."* Advent is a season of repentance and preparation. The purple vestments and Scripture readings all focus us on the Birth of Christ *and* His return in glory. Where do we place our focus personally, where are our minds, thoughts, words and activities during this busy time of year. Are we preparing and planning for the Lord's coming? Disciples can do nothing less.

You might have noticed some new monitors in the narthex this weekend. We have invested in these for several reasons. Instead of the static bulletin boards in the narthex, these monitors will provide updated information on events and happenings on a continuing basis. A side benefit is that the narthex will be clear of posters either hanging on the bulletin boards or on easels. We will still have the bulletin boards on the opposite side of Church for the other entrances, although with their limited space, there will most likely be more information on the monitors.

These monitors will also be usable for our large celebrations, such as Christmas and Easter, showing what is going on inside of our main Church during Mass. We have additionally upgraded our portable monitor which we use in the Chapel for such occasions. The portable monitor will now be used all year long in Vianney Hall for the many meetings that take place there and then brought over to Chapel for these special occasions. We are also upgrading the internet connection and Wi-Fi in the Church area for those who use electronic prayer books and missals.

If anyone is interested in helping us to coordinate and compose the messages for the monitors, we'd be grateful for the technological assistance to keep the monitor information up-to-date. In this information- and video-driven world of ours, we hope this addition will not only keep everyone current but also provide a welcoming and friendly atmosphere within our narthex. As St. Paul says in our second reading this weekend, *"Welcome one another, then, as Christ welcomed you, for the glory of God."* May God be glorified in all our efforts and may our discipleship be strengthened by God's grace and mercy.

Once again I am making a plea for your assistance and help to extend *Christmas greetings* to all our adult

parishioners and visitors, and of course our children as well. Our past experience has confirmed that your presence, smile, warm greetings, your wish for a Merry Christmas means quite a lot and works wonders not only for those you greet but for yourself as well.

In addition to a warm and heartfelt welcome of everyone who comes into Church for Christmas, we will be distributing to all the adults a copy of our Christmas gift-book, *Resisting Happiness* by Matthew Kelly. 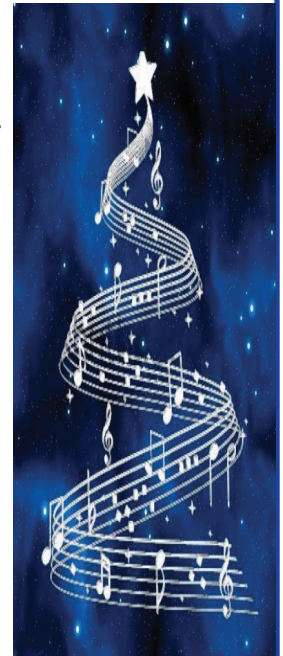
