Dear Friends,

A WORD

FROM THE

Blessed Advent to each of you and your loved ones! Advent is the time of patient expectation. As we await the celebration of Jesus' birth, we PASTOR are reminded of our awaiting His Second Coming at the end of time. Our lives are not meant

to be lived only in the here and now but in the fullness of eternity, in the glory of God. The Father sent His Son, Jesus, to look for us and to help us on the road to Paradise. May we turn to Him, seek Him, open our hearts to Him and learn from Him each and every day.

Sometime early in 2016, we offered a survey regarding Christmas Mass times and attendance. I shared the results with the Pastoral Council and the Liturgy Committee as well as the parish staff. I want to offer here some of the highlights from the survey. We had 812 respondents.

One surprising result was about Midnight Christmas Mass. Of the respondents, 68% indicated that they were not interested in attending Mass at that time while only 30% were. I remember growing up with Midnight Mass and have celebrated it in several of the parishes where I've been assigned. But it is not a time that would draw many people here at Saint Eleanor. Of course, we do have lots families with younger children which would make that time difficult.

An interesting result from the survey was that, of the respondents 70% attend one of the Masses on Christmas Eve, while 30% attend Christmas Day. That result is something that we, priests and deacons, have observed going through the Christmas Mass schedule these past few years.

Of the respondents to the survey, the overwhelming age group responding was 36-55 years old (64%). And, 59% were between 11 to 30 years in the parish. One final observation, a small number of people indicated an interest in an earlier time for the Christmas Vigil Masses than 4 pm. This is not possible as the earliest Vigil Mass time permitted by Church Law is 4 pm. We realize this is a very popular and very crowded time. It is impossible to get around the large crowd at that particular time as this is the earliest time permitted. However, let me share that the later Masses both on Christmas Eve and the Christmas morn~ ing Masses have space available for additional people and might be considered in your Christmas planning.

We are very aware of the parking situation at the 4/4:15 Masses. We are taking steps to try to assist those attending these Masses. We will have access to Ursinus College parking, off of Ninth Avenue. We will have 2 shuttle buses for those who park there, both before and after the Masses. If sufficient numbers take advantage of this opportunity, it will greatly help the situation on the parish campus. We will have more details available in the bulletin and on our website, so please check these out as you make your plans.

It is hard to believe that Christmas is coming so fast. But it is a truly joyful and blessed holy day. May we take full advantage of these Advent days to open our hearts, minds, bodies and souls to the gracious and transforming Love, who became flesh and blood, in order to redeem us and lead us to our Father.
