

A WORD FROM THE

Dear Friends,

A happy and blessed Palm Sunday to you and yours! We are entering into the holiest week of our liturgical year as we take time to celebrate PASTOR the Sacred Mysteries of Redemption on each of the days of the Paschal Triduum (Holy Thursday, Good Friday, Easter). This is the center and

focus of every celebration of Holy Mass, the center of our Faith. Christ came to reveal the hidden Face of the Father through His scourging, death on the Cross, and resurrection. This mystery of life arising out of death, glory shining from humiliation, joy lifted up from sorrows permeates not only the mystery of faith but each of our lives as well. As His disciples, we cannot expect our experience of life in this world to be different than that of our Savior's. But just as we experience the sorrows and the cross, so by His grace we experience God's power and life from above.

One certain way to prepare our hearts and souls to enter more deeply into God's love, mercy and power is through the **Sacrament of Confession**, Reconciliation. We have several opportunities still available ~ this Tuesday evening, 7 pm in Church (with many visiting priests helping to hear confessions), Good Friday, from 12:30 to 1:30 pm in Chapel, and Holy Saturday morning, 8-8:45 am in Chapel (our usual time). Please take advantage of the graces of this Sacrament and these additional opportunities and the priestly service of our priests. God is longing to pour out His mercy and healing on each of us! For us to receive, we need to show up.

The times of Masses and Services for the Easter Triduum are listed elsewhere in our bulletin but I do bring to your attention Morning Prayer in Chapel on Holy Thursday, Good Friday, Holy Saturday mornings at 9 am. The blessing of Food at 12 Noon on Holy Saturday and our first Easter Egg Hunt for those 6 and under at 11 am on Holy Saturday, on our lawn. On Easter Sunday, two additional Masses will be held in Campion Hall (Gym) at 9:05 and 10:35 am.

We are overjoyed to have 4 people coming into the Church through Baptism, Confirmation and Holy Communion at the Easter Vigil this year. This Vigil of Easter is one of the most beautiful liturgies we have all year long. If you have never attended the Easter Vigil, plan to do so this year. Please keep our Elect, the 4 who will be baptized at the Vigil, in your prayers.

Our Confirmation ceremonies were beautiful and inspiring as Bishop Edward Deliman confirmed 223 of our parish family with the full outpouring of the Holy Spirit through the laying on of hands and anointing with Sacred Chrism. Both Masses were filled to overflowing as family members gathered with the confirmandi. Thank you to Ms. Teri Lahey, our DRE, Mrs. Theresa Healy, principal of Holy Cross, their staffs, our catechists and teachers, our RCIA team, lectors, Altar Servers, musicians, parish staff and all who made this such a singular moment in our parish life. May the grace of the Holy Spirit set our hearts on fire to be Jesus' disciples who live in faith, hope and love throughout the year.

Finally, on the Sunday after Easter, April 23, Divine Mercy Sunday, a special Holy Hour with the recitation of the Divine Mercy Chaplet and Benediction will be celebrated in our Church. Check the bulletin and Facebook for details.







FAST AND ABSTINENCE AND OTHER ACTS OF **PENANCE FOR LENT 2017**

The Bishops of the United States prescribe, as minimal obligation, that all persons who are fourteen years of age and older are bound to abstain from eating meat on Ash Wednesday, March 1, 2017, on all the Fridays of Lent and Good Friday. Further, all persons eighteen years of age and older, up to and including their fifty-ninth birthday, are bound to fast by limiting themselves to a single full meal on Ash Wednesday and on Good Friday, while the other two meals on those days are to be light. All the faithful are encouraged, when possible, to participate at Mass and to receive the Holy Eucharist daily, to celebrate frequently the Sacrament of Penance, to undertake spiritual reading, especially the study of the Sacred Scriptures, and to participate in parish Lenten devotions as well as Lenten education programs. Adoration of the Blessed Sacrament is especially recommended.
