Archbishop Chaput, along with several other Bishops, have called for a meeting of the Bishops, a Synod, specifically on this crisis. In fact, Archbishop Chaput wrote the Holy Father to cancel the presently scheduled Synod in favor of addressing this topic now. The president of the US Bishops Conference, Cardinal DiNardo, has spoken directly about steps to be taken as soon as possible, renewing the commitment for greater effectiveness and transparency in disciplining Bishops.
