PASTOR \

Our Gospel account this weekend recalls Jesus' resurrection appearance to the Apostles at the Sea of Tiberius. They have gone fishing, in a sense back to what they knew. We can presume that they were still puzzled by all that had

happened. But Jesus pursues them and even offers them breakfast. Afterwards, Jesus speaks to Simon Peter who three times denied Him. On this day, Peter three times affirms his love for Jesus. Jesus commissions him to tend and feed His sheep, and to follow Him.

Jesus pursues each one of us, no matter where we are, no matter where we go. Day after day, Jesus not only waits for us but seeks us out and accompanies us on our daily routine. Do we turn to Him throughout the day? Do we acknowledge Him in our comings and goings? It doesn't need to be fancy. Just say, "Hi, Jesus!" Or lift up a petition to Him. Or tell Him that you love Him. And always tell Him that you are grateful to Him.

Prayer from the heart opens us up to His presence with us. Such praying allows Jesus to reveal Himself to us. It keeps us focused on the things above and not just on the things around us. It keeps us connected spiritually and helps us to see our life the way that God sees us.

As we move into this beautiful month dedicated to Mary, our Mother, may she teach us simplicity in praying to Jesus her Son. May she lead us to love more deeply and more tenderly our Savior, who loves us beyond all human understanding. Next weekend, our parish May devotion of crowning our Lady will take place at the end of the 10:30 am Mass. Our Youth Group and our First Communicants are invited to be special participants in this token of love and esteem for our Most Holy Mother.
