

Dear Friends,

This week, July 23-29, is National Natural Family Planning Awareness Week. The theme this year is: "It's time! Say 'Yes' to God's plan for Marriage! Natural Family Planning!" The Church is committed to helping married couples deepen their conjugal love and achieve responsible parenthood. This Awareness Week is both instructional and supportive of couples as they live out *God's Divine Plan for Human Love*.

In our broken, fragile world, human nature often looks for easy solutions or easy answers. Life, which is a total gift from God, does not lend itself to such ease in this world. As Pope Emeritus Benedict once said, "The world offers you comfort. But you were not made for comfort. You were made for greatness." And the greatness comes from God who has made us in His image and likeness and has sent His Spirit to dwell within us.

Marriage is an original gift from God to humanity. Although sin entered the world damaging the marital relationship, this gift was not lost but redeemed by Christ and raised to a sacrament (see Eph. 5:28-32; see also Mt. 19:4-6). It is Sacred Scripture that proclaims that God created humanity in "His image" as "male and female" (see Gen. 1:27). So unique is this relationship that the marital union makes of the husband and wife "one flesh" (Gen. 2:24). Scripture also teaches that procreation is a gift from God (Gen. 1:28). When spouses conceive new life, they participate in the Lord God's creative power. This is an awesome privilege and a sacred responsibility!

In Marriage, a husband and wife become one flesh, one heart and one soul. It therefore "demands indissolubility and faithfulness in ... mutual giving; and it is open to fertility" (*Familiaris Consortio, The Role of the Christian Family in the Modern World*, no. 13). Marriage is truly a vocation, a real calling from God to form a communion of persons, the one-flesh union spoken of in Genesis and reaffirmed by Jesus (see Gen 2:24; see also Matt 19:6).

Through the practice of the methods of Natural Family Planning, married couples can integrate God's design for life and love in their daily lives. At times, it won't be easy, since sacrifice and honest communication have to happen. If couples persevere, the benefits are well worth the effort! Husband and wife will see their love grow and deepen. Their hearts, and the heart of their marriage, will be open to all good gifts that the Lord God wishes to give them!


Opening of a New Catechetical Year




