A blessed and happy Father's Day to all Dads! A special blessing for Fathers will be given at the end of all our weekend Masses. As we say farewell and offer best wishes to Father Buck this weekend, we are preparing for Father Alessandro Giardini's arrival on Monday. Father Giardini joined us for the eighth grade Graduation Mass and ceremonies this past week. He actually taught the class when he was assigned here as an acolyte, a few years back. He is very excited to be coming here and I am excited to welcome him to our parish family. You will get to meet him next weekend for sure.

Today is the solemn feast of the Most Holy Trinity. This fundamental truth of our Faith is revealed to us by Jesus. We can know that there is a God from the natural elements around us and by reason; but the actual inner being of God Himself is His revelation to us. He shares this because of His immense and everlasting love for us. He desires to draw us to Himself more and more. Thanks to Matt Kirsch, Jed Cainglet, our young folks and adult volunteers for their dedication, support and efforts as disciples of the Lord.

The last week of June will see our second *Take the Plunge* week of religious education for our PREP students. This five-day program is taught by accredited teachers and includes both the study of the Faith and devotional experiences in faith formation. It was very successful last year, and we look forward to it this year. Confessions will be available on Wednesday afternoon, June 26 with many priests coming to assist us.

In response to the concerns of our PREP parents, and the ever-changing demands and complexities of family life, we are attempting to find creative ways to ensure the religious education and the faith formation of our young disciples and their families. In the Fall, there will be a Family Catechesis program available, which will be mostly home based but with a few large group gatherings as well. All of this supported by the PREP office, working with the parents and our students. Both initiatives require families to participate in some of our parish celebrations of Faith, such as Forty Hours, Holy Week, Stations of the Cross, Family Rosary, Confessions, or any of the many other devotional experiences we hold. The family chooses the five they attend together.

We give thanks to God for the many faith-filled and faithful disciples that make our parish so truly amazing. May God continue to bless each and every one and may you have some time for rest and relaxation during these summer months.

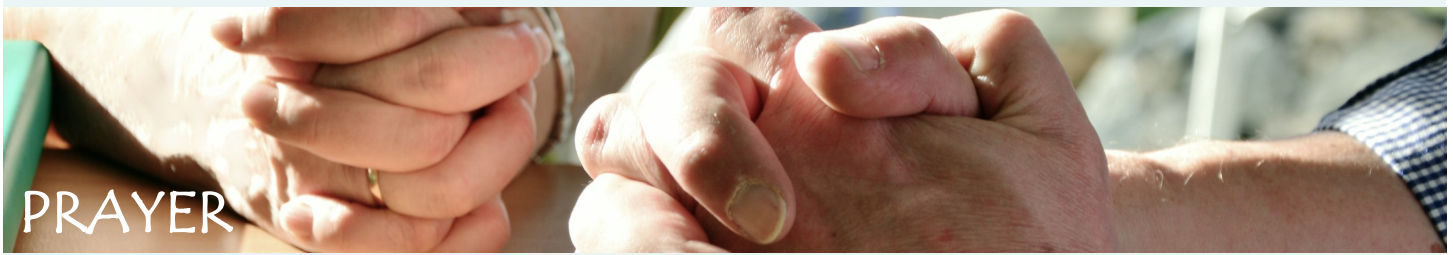

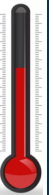
